CEDAR COUNTY REDISTRICTING & REPRECINCTING ORDINANCE NO. 63

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE REDISTRICTING AND REPRECINCTING OF CEDAR COUNTY FROM THE 2020 CENSUS AS REQUIRED BY IOWA CODE [49.3(4), 331.209-331.210A]

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Cedar County, Iowa:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE: The purpose of this ordinance is to establish election precincts for Cedar County to comply with current laws due to the 2020 federal decennial census.

SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS: For use in this ordinance, the following terms or words shall be interpreted or defined as follows:

- 1. "Voting Precinct" or "Precinct" shall mean a county or municipal subdivision for casting and counting votes in elections.
- 2. "Township" shall mean a civil and political subdivision of the county.

SECTION 3. ELECTION PRECINCTS: Cedar County shall have twelve (12) election precincts established and defined as follows:
