



## CEDAR COUNTY CONSERVATION BOARD

Regular Monthly Meeting  
Minutes – March 09, 2026  
Conservation Office

MEMBERS PRESENT: Dylan Haub, Duane Moeller , Teresa Wendt (On Speaker Phone), Pam Hartwig, and Rick Rouse

STAFF PRESENT: Andy Petersen, Chip Brown, Jacob Wilbourne and Sarah Subbert

Meeting was called to order by Chairman Haub at 6:02 p.m.

Motion from Rouse seconded by Wendt to approve the minutes. Motion carried.

Motion from Haub seconded by Rouse to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: Haub said that Supervisor Barnhart thanked the conservation staff for offering to help out the courthouse maintenance staff with mowing and snow when needed.

Director Petersen updated the board on the Bennett cabin project. Discussed a Latta estimate for testing the well, and getting water to the cabin and updating water system for the whole campground by adding an on-demand pressure system. Moeller moved to move forward with the well test and the plumbing to the cabin, Haub seconded. Motion carried.

Director Petersen gave a short update on the budget, and advised the Supervisors passed the 26/27 budget.

Director Petersen advised the board that the Sheriff requested the placement of a Flock camera system at Bennett Park. This camera system will monitor activity on Hwy 130 as it passes Bennett Park. The Sheriff acquired this system through a grant and will not cost the conservation board any dollars. Moeller moved to approve Hartwig seconded. Motion carried.

Director Petersen updated the board on the body worn cameras that the Director and Park Ranger use. The current Motorola cameras are obsolete and are no longer supported. Director Petersen reached out to three companies that offer these cameras. The best option would be to go with Axon who offer a five year contract for \$2000.00 a year. That includes two cameras and unlimited storage in their evidence system, and at the 2.5 year of the contract they will replace the cameras with new ones. Director Petersen also applied for a local grant to help offset the cost of the system. Rouse moved to approve Wendt seconded. Motion carried.
